**What is Futsal?** Futsal is an exciting, fast-paced small sided game that focuses on technique and skill over size and athleticism. Futsal is FIFA's official indoor soccer game which is, essentially, a scaled down version of outdoor soccer played indoors. It is a small sided game (5v5) played on a smaller field (roughly basketball court sized) with a smaller (size 3-4) ball. Futsal is played with touchline boundaries. There are no walls in

play. This is the game that outdoor soccer players around the globe play when they are indoors to refine and maintain their control skills and touch.

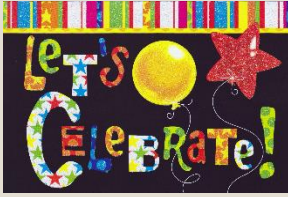
### STOA – Parent Meeting
